**What:** Live on the USS Lexington, visit the Naval Air Station and go Fishing.

**Equipment/Clothing Required:** We will be staying on the Lexington two Nights. All Scouts and Adults will be in crew quarters. They will have showers and restrooms. These have shower and toilet stalls with doors on each one. Each person will need a sleeping bag, pillow, towel, change of cloths and personal hygiene items. You will be walking so bring comfortable shoes. Remember, scouts must wear their Class "A" uniform at all times on this campout except in you living areas or at physical training. It is your ID Card! Each person should bring a water bottle. Watch the weather for needed coats and raingear.

**Cost:** Total cost will be \$160.00 per person plus some spending money, which I think \$40.00 will be fine. We will stop on the way down to CC and on the way back to Dallas Sunday so the group may get some food. Breakfast is on the LEX both days as well as Dinner Saturday night. The LEX will give us a sack lunch Saturday. We will have a tour of the Air Station Saturday during the day then back to the LEX for their tour and evening events. Up early Sunday for the ride to Port Aransas to go Bay fishing at 8AM off the boat at noon, lunch and then the ride home.
