Remember, scouts must wear their Class "A" uniform when traveling to and from campouts and at all times when out of the Barracks. It is your ID Card! Each person should bring a water bottle. Also you will be given Physical training Saturday morning so bring your running shoes and work out gear.

Cost: All meals will be in the Dining Hall. \$4.20 per person for morning meals and Dinner Saturday is \$4.95. Lunch Saturday will be MRE's provided by our host unit. Each will pay for their meal as they go through the line. Bowling is \$3.25 per game per person and bowling shoes are \$1.75 to rent. Please bring extra spending money for trip, Museum purchase and for the Church service Sunday Morning. I'm guessing that \$25.00 plus spending money will do.
